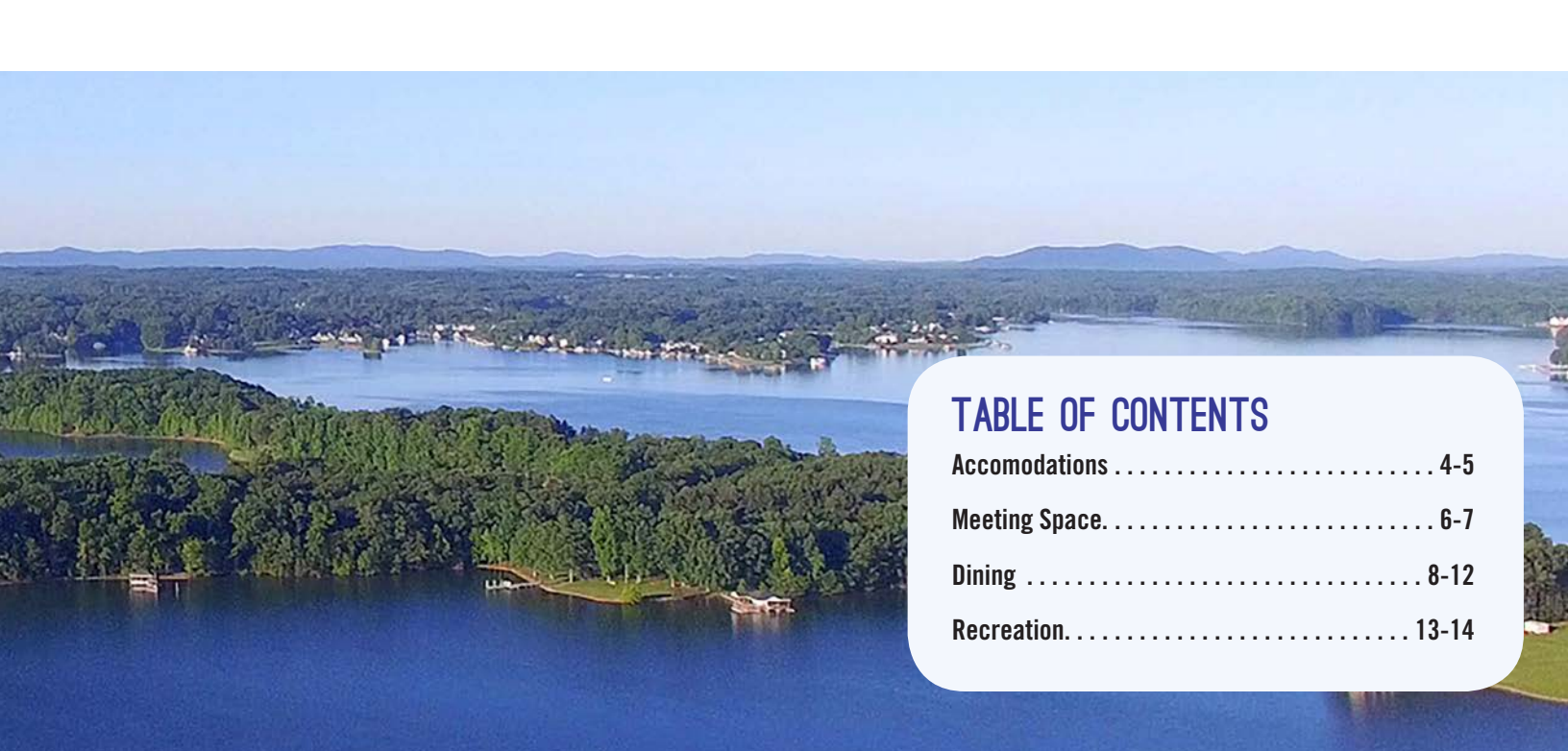

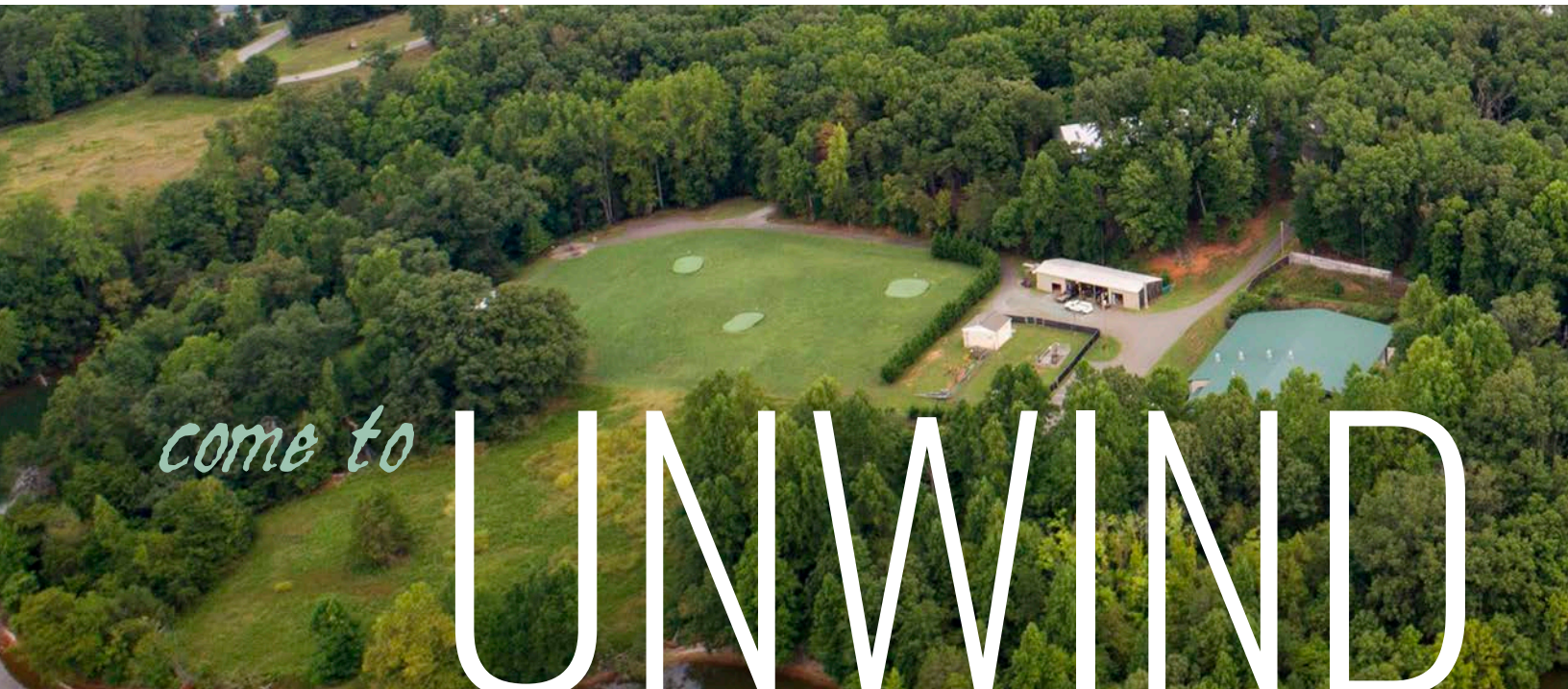

ACCOMMODATIONS

The majority of our guests are housed in hotel-style lodges that accommodate up to four guests per room. The larger *Reid Jones Jr. Lodge* has 38 rooms, each with one full bed, two twin beds and a trundle bed – an accompanying suite has three queen beds. The *Hepler-Jamison Lodge* has 15 rooms, each with two twin beds and one set of bunk beds – an accompanying suite has two double beds and a sofa sleeper, and one additional room has one twin and one full bed.

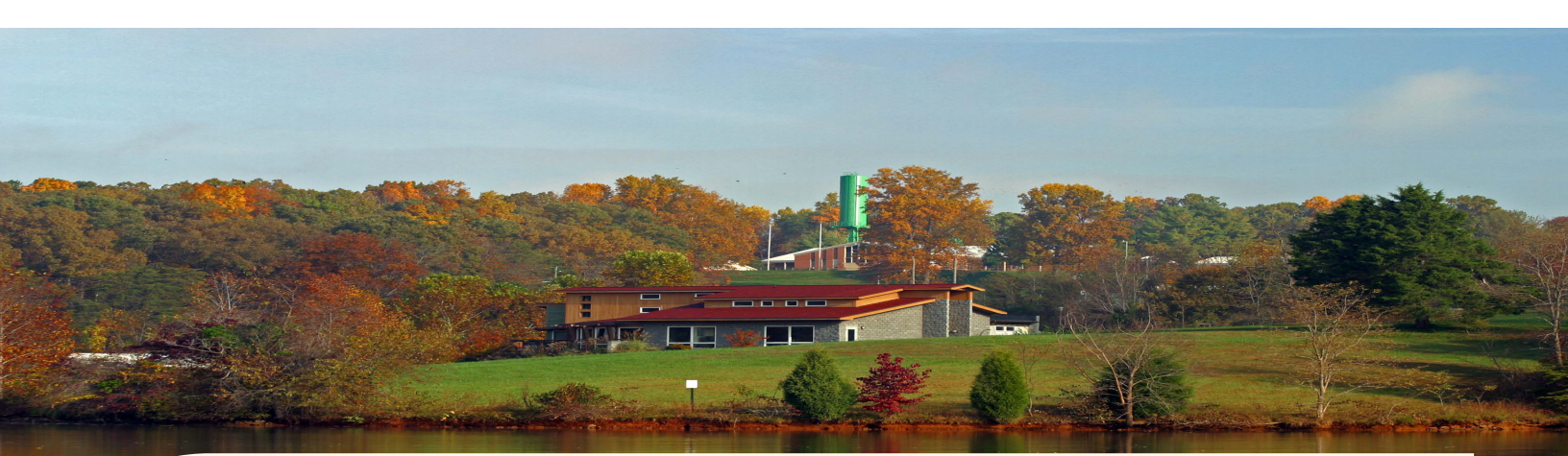

MEETING SPACE

Guests and visitors check in at the **Hahn Welcome Center**, the first building at the entrance to the conference center grounds. Administrative offices and additional meeting spaces are also located here.

The **Smith Central Activities Building** is at the center of the campus, capable of accommodating 500 in theater-style seating for presentations.

The **Taubman Conference Center & Reid Jones Jr. Upper and Lower Conference Rooms** are well-equipped facilities designed to accommodate the dynamic needs of any group. They are conveniently located within our hotel-style lodges.

Each dormitory-style lodge has common **In-Lodge Meeting Rooms** that can be accessed without entering guest sleeping areas.

The **JOCO Learning Center** is located at the front of campus and features a full kitchen, a multi-purpose meeting room and computer classrooms.

The Center's *Open Air Pavilion* is located within a tall stand of stately mixed hardwood trees. This natural setting can accommodate up to 400 guests.
